ONLINE COURSE FEE	NZD 1,500 - launch price until 30 September 2026 NZD 1,800 - from 1 October 2026 The same fee applies to all students.

COURSE FEE - LAUNCH PRICE

The online Course fee is NZD 1,500 for purchases made on or before 30 September 2026. This is the introductory launch price.

From 1 October 2026, the online Course fee is NZD 1,800.

The same price applies to all students, regardless of country.

1. AGREEMENT AND ENROLMENT

This agreement records the terms on which the Provider supplies the Course to the Student. By purchasing, accessing or using the Course, the Student confirms that they have read and accepted these terms.

2. ONLINE AND SELF-DIRECTED FORMAT

The Course is delivered online and is designed for self-directed study. It includes personalised digital copies of the lessons, videos, manuals and supporting resources described at the time of purchase.

The Provider will provide access to the Course within two working days after both the signed agreement and full payment have been received by the Provider. This preparation period is required to personalise the Course materials for the named Student, including adding identifying watermarks to manuals and videos to help protect intellectual property and prevent unauthorised sharing. For this purpose, working days are Monday to Friday, excluding public holidays observed in Christchurch, New Zealand.

The delivery method will be stated at purchase. The download period and access conditions are set out in clause 5.

3. NO SUPPORT INCLUDED

Unless the Provider expressly agrees otherwise in writing, the online Course does not include live tutoring, personal consultations, individual feedback, assessment of the Student's work, troubleshooting relating to prosthetic fabrication or practical techniques, mentoring, business advice, clinical supervision or in-studio assistance. Assistance is limited to accessing and opening the supplied Course materials and resolving video playback issues. It does not include answering questions about prosthetic fabrication, materials, techniques or practical application of the Course content.

4. STUDENT RESPONSIBILITY

The Student is responsible for completing the lessons, practising safely, selecting suitable materials and working within their own competence, qualifications, insurance and the laws applying where they practise. Completion of the Course does not itself grant a medical, clinical, cosmetic, tattooing or other professional licence.

5. COURSE ACCESS AND TECHNOLOGY

The Student will have 30 days from the date access to the Course materials is provided to download those materials. The Student is responsible for downloading all supplied Course materials within this period and securely storing and retaining their downloaded files for continued personal use under the licence in clause 6. The 30-day period is a download window and does not require the Student to complete their study within that time. Continued online access, replacement access

and replacement copies after the download period are not guaranteed, subject to any rights or remedies that cannot lawfully be excluded. The Student must use a compatible device and reliable internet connection and keep login details secure. Access is for the named Student only. If the Student cannot access, download or open the supplied Course materials, or a video does not play correctly, they should promptly notify the Provider so that the issue can be addressed within the download period. The Provider will provide reasonable assistance to resolve the access, download or playback issue. This assistance does not include tuition or advice on the practical techniques taught in the Course.

6. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY AND PERSONAL LICENCE

All Course videos, manuals, text, images, demonstrations, colour recipes, charts, templates and other materials remain the intellectual property of Darya Mikhaliouk or the relevant rights holder. The named Student receives a personal, non-transferable licence to study the materials and apply the skills learned in their own professional practice. The Student may print the manual for personal study and reference. Course videos may be viewed only by the named Student, without third parties present.

7. PROHIBITED USES

The Student must not share, distribute, sell, sublicense or provide others with access to the Course materials. This includes lending printed manuals, sharing files or login details, and showing Course videos to others. The Student must not use or adapt the Course content to teach others without the Provider's prior written permission. Watermarks and identifying information must not be removed, obscured or altered.

8. OPTIONAL UPGRADE TO IN-STUDIO TRAINING

The Student may request an upgrade to corresponding personal in-studio training in Christchurch within three calendar months of the Purchase Date, meaning the date the Provider receives full payment for the online Course. The amount actually paid for the online Course may be credited to the in-studio course fee, subject to available dates, the Provider's acceptance and payment of the remaining balance. Before the Student commits, the Provider will confirm the in-studio price, the credit and the balance payable. Travel, accommodation, visas, insurance, models and items not expressly included are the Student's responsibility. The credit is personal, non-transferable and cannot be exchanged for cash.

9. CONFIDENTIALITY AND PERSONALISED COPY

Course files may be marked with the Student's name or other identifying information. The Student must keep non-public Course materials and access credentials confidential. Personalisation is used to identify the licensed recipient and help protect the Course from unauthorised distribution.

10. FEES, CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS

The applicable Course fee and total payable will be stated in the Student's invoice, in accordance with the pricing in this agreement. The online Course fee is payable as agreed at purchase.

Once access to the digital Course has been supplied, no refund, cancellation or exchange is available for a change of mind. No refund is provided solely because the Student does not complete the Course, expects support that is expressly excluded under clause 3, or does not use or qualify for the optional in-studio upgrade.

However, nothing in this agreement excludes, restricts or modifies any right or remedy that cannot lawfully be excluded, including applicable rights under the Consumer Guarantees Act 1993 and Fair Trading Act 1986.

11. SUSPENSION AND TERMINATION

The Provider may suspend access while investigating suspected account sharing, unauthorised distribution or another material breach. If a material breach is established and is not remedied when capable of remedy, the Provider may terminate access and pursue available remedies. Termination does not transfer ownership of the materials or permit continued copying or distribution.

12. EDUCATIONAL NATURE AND RESULTS

The Course provides education and demonstrations based on the Provider's experience. Results vary with practice, materials, judgement and individual circumstances. No particular commercial income, client outcome or technical result is guaranteed. This clause does not limit any mandatory consumer guarantee.

13. PRIVACY

The Provider may collect and use the Student's contact, payment, access and enrolment information to supply the Course, administer this agreement, personalise materials, protect legitimate intellectual property interests, and meet tax record-keeping obligations. Information will be handled in accordance with applicable New Zealand privacy law.

14. NOTICES AND CHANGES

Notices under this agreement may be sent to the email addresses used for the purchase. Any amendment to this agreement must be recorded in writing and agreed by both parties. Operational updates that do not materially reduce the purchased Course may be communicated electronically.

15. GOVERNING LAW AND DISPUTES

This agreement is governed by New Zealand law. The parties will first try in good faith to resolve any concern directly. If it cannot be resolved, either party may use any court, tribunal or dispute-resolution process with jurisdiction. Nothing here prevents the Student from exercising mandatory consumer rights.

16. ENTIRE AGREEMENT AND SEVERABILITY

This agreement, together with the Course description and any written purchase terms, records the agreement between the parties about the Course. If a provision is unlawful or unenforceable, it will be read down or severed to the minimum extent required without affecting the remaining provisions.

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ACCEPTANCE & SIGNATURES

By signing below, each party confirms that they have read, understood and accepted this agreement. The Student acknowledges that the Course is online and self-directed, that practical tuition and advice are not included, and that clause 10 applies subject to mandatory consumer law.
